



Vision Care expands

Last week *OT* met with the founder of Vision Care, Harinder Paul, to speak about his plans to expand its clinics across London and taking the charity nationwide. Vision Care – a service that provides free sight tests and spectacles to the homeless – has tested over 1,500 pairs of eyes since it established itself at the Crisis Centre for the homeless, London, in September 2003. Mr Paul will give a presentation in the House of Lords on October 4 in a bid to increase awareness and raise funds among the optical profession.
